Main Theme and Suggested Topics:

For the **JoDLA 11-2026**, the Editors and the Editorial Board of the Journal of Digital Landscape Architecture cordially invite you to submit abstracts for original, unpublished presentations focusing on the conference's main theme of the **27th Digital Landscape Architecture Conference** in Dublin:

Cutting Edge

Abstracts on "Cutting Edge" are encouraged in one of the four broad themes in Digital Landscape Architecture.

1: Computation and Digital Technologies - Focuses on breakthroughs in **digital modeling**, leveraging **algorithmic design**, **visualization**, **simulation**, **machine learning**, **AI**, **AR**, **VR**, **remote sensing**, **UAV imagery**, and more, for transformative landscape architecture applications.

2: Ecological and Environmental Resilience - Explores the integration of digital tools in promoting nature-based solutions, enhancing climate resilience, analyzing and preserving biodiversity, and optimizing environmental sensing for sustainable landscapes.

3: Human-Centric, Community, and Participatory Design - Highlights the intersection of human perception, cognition, and interaction with digital interfaces, together with community-driven, participatory design methodologies enabled by advanced digital tools.

4: Educational Innovation and Capacity Building - Investigates the evolution and evaluation of teaching methods, learning strategies, and knowledge dissemination in digital landscape architecture, development.

Presentation of selected papers at the upcoming DLA-Con

Accepted papers of the peer review are published in a [hardcopy publication](#), as e-paper, and as [open access paper](#). Of the papers accepted, the DLA 2026 conference team will select a number of them for presentation at the conference. In order to underscore the focus of the conference, the host will select papers which focus specifically on the main theme. Accepted authors should try, as early as possible, to find resources that allow them to present in person, whenever feasible.
