The Digital Landscape Architecture (DLA) conference focuses on innovative applications, methods, and critical reflections on digital and computational technologies in landscape architecture. Contributions should therefore explicitly address the development, application, evaluation, or implications of digital tools, computational methods, or data-driven approaches in planning, design, research, or education. Submissions that merely report the routine use of established software tools (e.g. GIS or CAD) without methodological or conceptual innovation fall outside the main scope of the conference. Within this digital perspective, contributions are encouraged in the following thematic areas:

- 01: Social, Ethical, and Governance Aspects of Digital Technologies
- 02: Ecological Adaptation and Environmental Systems
- 03: Participatory and Collaborative Design
- 04: Education and Capacity Building

The journal publishes original papers in English that address theoretical and practical issues, innovative developments, methods, applications, findings, and case studies that are drawn primarily from work presented at the annual international DLA-Con Digital Landscape Architecture Conference. Its intent is to encourage the broad dissemination of these ideas, innovations, and practices. The Journal of Digital Landscape Architecture is listed in the international citation database Scopus. It is in the top 35% of all journals in the engineering / architecture category. JoDLA is listed in DOAJ (Directory of Open Access Journals).

The author's fee for the publication is currently 450 Euros for the standard 8 pages of print with the option of publishing extra pages at 70 Euros per additional page. With this contribution towards the publishing cost you also receive an author's copy. For the author's team, additional books at a reduced price are available. The author's publication fee includes the author's hard copy and the open access publication at www.jodla.info.
